## Joy of Generosity

Dear CLC members,

Perhaps I share your astonishment at how the *Just Imagine* campaign has taken on life—the banners, the devotion book, the prayer vigil and countless other initiatives introduced almost every Sunday are some of the manifestations. *Just Imagine* has seeped into our services and the way we are thinking about discipleship and our own faith. Allow me to explain.

A new phrase has surfaced in our Prayers of Intercession, Offering Prayer and both Pastor Tim's and Pastor Erica's sermons and announcements. The phrase is the "joy of generosity." I am not certain about the etymology of the phrase. A quick Google search shows that it is widely used, but in our congregation Pastor Tim introduced it at Church Council this past January, as the council was prayerfully trying to discern if our call was to initiate the Just *Imagine* campaign to free our finances so we can creatively envision new ministries

I have been thinking of this phrase, "joy of generosity," for months now and to a

large extent it encapsulates what *Just Imagine* is about and our idealized response. The campaign is about paying down the mortgage on our new sanctuary and meeting space and thus allowing the church budget to fund new, creative ways to assist and witness to our neighbors and grow spiritually ourselves. That is the "just imagine" part, the part of infinite possibility.

But the phrase "joy of generosity" asks us to rethink our priorities. As Christians we are taught to give of ourselves and our treasures. Through the church, the Men's Shelter or Valparaiso University I give of myself to help others. However, as a frugal Lutheran, I often hesitate at parting with my wages. This

doesn't mean I don't like spending money; just the opposite, when it comes to aero road bikes I have few restraints, to which family and friends can attest. Maybe this is why the "joy of generosity" is confounding to me, it means submerging my own desires and elevating those that benefit others. It is Christ's message. It means envisioning a spirit-filled life where we calculate what we need and what we can share. Where the marker between fending for ourselves and giving to others is blurred, because our individual sense of identity is meshed with that of the community.

And then one step more. I trust I will derive joy from giving. For me the *Just Imagine* campaign is so much more than paying on the mortgage, it is asking me to reevaluate who I am in relationship to others, to find out how far I am willing to go to be a disciple of Christ and to risk that the benefits of generosity will be revealed in deepening my faith.

Thank you for supporting the *Just Imagine* campaign and together may we learn how to give joyfully.
