

# CLC Plan to Regather - what does it mean for...

## Worship

In our Limited/Hybrid phase, worship will remain significantly different than usual.

- **Sunday Morning Livestream will remain our central worship gathering**, as medical, denominational and governmental guidance continue to indicate that in-person worship services are a high-risk activity, and steps to reduce that risk affect nearly every aspect of our worship life (no singing, no unison speech like the Lord's Prayer, no Communion, no Offerings, no Peace, no hymnals, no sitting together, wearing masks at all times, and more).
- **Small (50 persons max) outdoor worship experiments will supplement the livestream.**
  - Physical distancing of 6 feet will be kept
  - Online registration (to keep track of numbers) will be sent by email and on the CLC webpage
  - Masks are encouraged outdoors and required if the building is entered (for restroom, etc)
  - You're welcome to bring your own chair to limit contact, though folding chairs will be available as well
  - Know that your in-person presence at the CLC facility for any reason implies consent for staff to share contact information in any contact tracing efforts related to possible COVID-19 exposure

## **Individual facility use at CLC**

In our Limited/Hybrid phase, individuals are able to enter CLC facilities to tend to ministry needs or for prayer in the sanctuary, with the following guidelines:

- **Connect with the church office (email, telephone) to arrange a time to visit.** (Limit of 10 people, including staff, in main building and 10 in education wing, with door to main building closed.)
- **Use only Door 3** (Office Door) on Campbell St. to enter and exit.
- Find the **Sign In/Sign Out sheet on the table by the door**, and use it!
- Use best practices -
  - Bring a mask and have it available to wear if you are around any other people
  - Limit surface contact, wash hands as you arrive and before you leave
  - Sanitize high-touch surfaces after use
- Anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, or concerned they may have been exposed, are asked to stay home and contact the Pastors.
- Prayer in the Sanctuary can be arranged by signup (link will be on the CLC webpage by mid-June) -
  - Please use the provided wipe to sanitize hard surfaces around your seat before and after your visit
- Know that your in-person presence at the CLC facility for any reason implies consent for staff to share contact information in any contact tracing efforts related to possible COVID-19 exposure

## **CLC Plan to Regather - what does it mean for...**

### **In-person ministry group gathering at CLC**

Remembering that home is still safest, and that in-person gatherings will be substantially different from “the usual,” CLC ministry groups (not outside groups) are able to use CLC facilities in our Limited/Hybrid phase, with the following guidelines:

- **Coordinate any plan to gather with the church office in advance**
- Plan in-person gatherings to be **outside if at all possible**
- High-risk folk are asked to stay home and safe, especially from indoor meetings
- Organizers will **use a registration process/sign-in sheet to record attendance.**
- **Gatherings should not exceed 50 if outdoors, 10 if indoors.**
- **Six-foot distancing is always expected,** outdoors and indoors
- **Masks are mandatory if indoors, recommended if outdoors.**  
A limited number of masks are available for those who need them.
- Any indoor meetings will take place in the Church Hall, Gathering Area, or Activity Center - encourage airflow with open doors.
- Group **organizers should plan to sanitize surfaces and areas used.** Wipes and materials will be provided.
- Food is discouraged; any foods to be consumed must be prepackaged.
- Anyone experiencing symptoms, or concerned they may have been exposed, are asked to stay home and contact the Pastors.
- Restroom use - limits on numbers using at the same time, identify distancing via tape on the floor, define routes to and from, doors should remain propped open.
- Remember that in-person presence at the CLC facility for any reason implies their consent for staff to share contact information in any contact tracing efforts related to possible COVID-19 exposure

## **CLC Plan to Regather - what does it mean for...**

### **In-person gathering of outside groups**

Outside groups will not gather at CLC in the Limited/Hybrid phase of our Health Plan.

- The only exceptions anticipated are for urgent needs approved by Council Executive Committee, on a case-by-case basis.
